From I-5: Exit on Genesee Avenue and go east. Turn right on Campus Point Drive. Shiley Eye Institute is located on the left; Thornton Hospital is located on the right. To get to the Moore's Cancer Center, turn left on Medical Center Drive and follow it around Shiley Eye Institute to Health Sciences Drive.

From I-805: Exit on La Jolla Village Drive/Miramar Road, and go west. Turn right on Genesee Avenue, then turn left on Campus Point Drive. Shiley Eye Institute is located on the left; Thornton Hospital is located on the right. To get to Moore's Cancer Center, turn left on Medical Center Drive and follow it around Shiley Eye Institute to Health Sciences Drive.

Parking Lot 756, the Athena Parking Lot

Costs for Lots and Structures:

- \$4 for first two hours and \$1 for each additional hour (\$8 daily maximum)
- With a handicapped placard, parking is free in any patient or visitor spot
- Park and then pay at pay stations in structure or lot before entering clinic or hospital
- There are two ways you can add parking time. You can extend your parking time by text. Use a credit card to pay for parking at the pay station and when prompted, add your cell phone number. You will receive a reminder text message when your parking is about to expire. To extend your parking time, reply to the text message with the amount of parking time you need. You can also add additional time at the machines located at Moore's Cancer Center (first-floor lobby) and near at the entrance to Shiley Eye Institute. You will need to use the "add time" code that is on your parking receipt.
